(BROOKLYN, NY – January 28, 2013) — *Collaborations* showcases four groups of artists working together to create work about identity and place. Within this exhibition, there are a variety of approaches to developing visual ideas between multiple artists, across physical spaces and time and in some cases collaborating with the viewer. By working with more than one person, these artists expand notions of identity, perspective, and ownership.

PATRICIA BRACE & RITA LEDUC *Dot Your T's and Cross Your Eyes* is a collaboration that combines concepts of performance, mindfulness, process-as-art, and public space in a real-time, site-specific improvisational response.

NIKI GRANUTH & JAMES KINSER *MUSE*, explores issues of gender identity and the tradition of artist/muse relationship.

JOE E. JEFFREYS & VES PITTES In *Alter/Alters*, video artist Joe E. Jeffreys, and photographer Ves Pitts, invite visual and performance artists to sit in front of a mirror and alter or transform themselves in any way they see fit.

GEORGE HEINTZ, VICTORIA DUFFEE & CARLY PLANKER In *Crypsis*, artists explore the theme of imitation and camouflage. Photographs taken by Carly Planker, address the uncanny rift between actual travel experience and the expectation of travel through advertising. Where advertising begs to be seen in its idealized mimicry of the natural world, Victoria Duffee and George Heintz touch upon mimicry with the intent to disappear.
